

**Notice for 2<sup>nd</sup> Round Off-line Counselling for admission in the Govt. ITIs.**

**Phase-I: Counselling centre at Govt. ITI Malda:** Allotment of seats for ITIs at North Bengal.

**Covered Govt. ITIs:** Seat allotment will be given for admission in all the Govt. ITIs located in the districts of Malda, Uttar Dinajpur, Dakshin Dinajpur, Jalpaiguri, Cooch-beher, Alipurduar & Darjeeling (Except ITI Tung & ITI Kalimpong).

**Reporting Schedule:** Candidates with rank up-to 20000 will attend on 22.08. 19 at 9.00am.  
Rank from 20,001 & up-to 40000 will attend on 23.08.19 at 9.00am.  
Rank 40,001 and above will attend on 24.08.19 at 9.00am.

**Phase-II: Counselling centre at Govt. ITI Tollygunj: Special admission drive for Women Candidates.**

**Covered Govt. ITIs:** Seat allotment will be given for 04 Women Govt. ITI at Kolkata, Banipur, Burdwan, Siliguri & ITI for Physically Challenged at Kolkata.

**Reporting Schedule:** Candidates with any rank will attend on 27.08. 19 at 9.00 am.

**Phase-III: Counselling centre at Govt. ITI Tollygunj:**

**Covered Govt. ITIs:** Seat allotment will be given in few newly affiliated trades of Govt. ITI Amtala (South 24 Pgs.) and Govt. ITI Rupnarayanpur (Paschim Burdwan).

**Reporting Schedule:** Candidates with rank up-to 5000 will attend on 27.08. 19 at 1.00 pm.

**3<sup>rd</sup> Round of Off-line Counselling: through Physical reporting of Candidates:**

Remaining vacant seats after 2<sup>nd</sup> Round of Off-line Counselling will be filled up through physical reporting of the candidates at any Govt. ITI.

**Covered ITIs :** All Govt. & PTP Govt. ITIs.

**Reporting Schedule:** On 28.08.19 at 11.00 am. Candidates with any rank may attend at the particular Govt. ITI where he/she intends to take admission. Admission will be offered subject to availability of vacant seats of the concerned ITI only.

**4<sup>th</sup> Round of Off-line Counselling: For non-rank holder candidates:**

**Reporting Schedule:** On 30.08.19 at 11.00 am. Non-rank holders may attend at the respective Govt. ITI. Admission will be given on the basis of marks obtained in the Madhyamik Examination and subject to availability of vacant seats.

**Special Note:** Candidates who have already taken admission and/or seat allotment letter from 1<sup>st</sup> Phase of counselling are not eligible for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> Round of counselling.
