Submission of Marks of Qualifying Examination by the Applicants of JEXPO & VOCLET 2020

This is for information of all concerned applicants of JEXPO & VOCLET 2020 that after careful consideration of the present situation under "COVID-19" pandemic, the WBSCT&VE&SD has decided to cancel the Entrance Examinations of JEXPO & VOCLET 2020.

The admission of students to the Polytechnics of the State of West Bengal for the academic session 2020-21 will be made based on the marks obtained by the applicants in the Board/Council Examination. Two separate Merit Lists will be prepared, one "**Merit List for admission to 1**st **year Diploma Course [ML-JEXPO]**" and the other "**Merit List for admission to 2**nd **year Diploma Courses through Lateral Entry Scheme [ML-VOCLET]**". The modalities for preparation of both the merit lists will be notified in the council's website in due course of time.

A link in the Council's Website <u>www.webscte.co.in</u> will soon be available for submission of marks and other details by the applicants of JEXPO & VOCLET (Both Online & Offline). Last date for submission of marks and other details is 20.09.2020. The applicants, who will not submit the marks and other details through the online portal of the Council within stipulated date as above, their application will be rejected and will not consider for preparation of merit lists. The application money of such applicants will also be forfeited.

The online counselling for admission to Diploma Courses will be made on the basis of the Merit Lists [ML-JEXPO and ML-VOCLET] to be published by the Council. If a candidates selected provisionally for admission based on the aforesaid merit lists and subsequently at the time of document verification at institute level it is found that the marks he/she provided is more than what he/she has actually obtained (as in his/her mark-sheets), then his/her provisional admission will be cancelled without assigning any reason thereto.

If any Board/Council does not provide any marks (only grade) to the candidates in board examination, then the candidates of that particular Board/Council have to convert their grades into marks as per the rules of that concerned Board/Council and should enter that marks into the online marks providing portal.
