SPECIAL ONLINE COUNSELLING

**For admission of candidates to different Diploma Courses in Polytechnics
of the State of West Bengal (Academic Session 2020-2021)**

With the approval of Government in the Department of Technical Education, Training & Skill Development, WBSCT&VE&SD conducted online counselling in three phases for admission of candidates to 1st & 2nd year of Diploma Courses in all Government and Government Sponsored Polytechnics in the State of West Bengal (except Darjeeling Polytechnic and Kalimpong Government Polytechnic), based on the Provisional Merit Lists published. After completion of counselling and admission process, it has been observed that few seats of 1st & 2nd year under certain categories in Government / Government Sponsored Polytechnics are lying vacant.

Now, with the approval of the competent authority, WBSCT&VE&SD has decided to conduct a **Special Online Counselling** to fill-up those vacant seats of Government / Government Sponsored Polytechnics by reopening of application panel for the candidates who have applied earlier but could not take part in the counselling due to different reasons or could not take admission due to submission of wrong information by providing them an opportunity for correction of earlier submitted information and take part in the counselling process for admission in the remaining vacant seats of **1st & 2nd year of Diploma Courses**. **The candidates, who have already taken admission in any polytechnic through recently concluded online counselling are NOT ELIGIBLE for this Special Online Counselling.**

Following categories of candidates are allowed to take part in the aforesaid Special Online Counselling:–

- The candidates, who were somehow missed to submit their relevant marks or could not register themselves for online counselling within stipulated time frame;
- The candidates, who submitted wrong information with respect to TFW, LLQ, EXS, EWS, PC, Category, etc. and/or marks due to ignorance or inadvertence or conversion from grade to marks and thereby denied admission by the concerned polytechnic even after getting allotment of seat; and
- The candidates, who were somehow missed to apply for admission in polytechnics and have valid eligibility criteria as per norms of admission.

The Application Panel for **Special Online Counselling** will be available in the council’s website (www.webscte.co.in) from **19.11.2020** and will remain activated till **25.11.2020 (Up to 11.30 PM)**. On the basis of applications received, WBSCT&VE&SD will prepare and publish two separate merit lists for both 1st & 2nd year, based on the marks obtained by the candidates in qualifying examination, **1st one** – for those who have already applied earlier for admission to polytechnics (**mentioned under serial (a) & (b) above**) and **2nd one** – for those who will apply for admission afresh (**mentioned under serial (c) above**).

The candidates of proposed 1st Merit List will be allotted rank first i.e. from General Rank 1 and the rank of the candidates of proposed 2nd Merit List will be allotted thereafter i.e. after the last rank of 1st Merit List and the counselling for admission in Government and Government Sponsored Polytechnics in the Special Online Counselling will be made based on the said General Rank. Only one round of counselling will be conducted and no auto upgradation option will be there i.e. the merit listed candidates will be allotted seat finally according to their rank.

If a candidate selected provisionally for admission based on the aforesaid merit lists and subsequently at the time of document verification at institute level it is found that the marks he/she provided is more than what he/she has actually obtained (as per in his/her mark-sheets), then his/her provisional admission will be cancelled without assigning any reason thereto. If any Board/Council does not provide any marks (only grade) to the candidates in board examination, then the candidates of that particular Board/Council have to convert their grades into marks as per the rules of that concerned Board/Council and should enter that marks into the online marks providing portal.
