Sub: Guidelines for admission to remaining vacant seats of 1st year Diploma Courses in Pharmacy for the session 2021-22 in Government Polytechnics.

West Bengal State Council of Technical and Vocational Education and Skill Development is opening the process of **SPOT ADMISSION** to the Diploma Courses in Pharmacy to fill up the vacant seats in the institutes under the Council.

Candidates will have to appear in person with all documents as listed below by 9:00 AM on the 10th December, 2021, at the Institute of his /her choice. Application Forms will be accepted from willing candidates till 1:00 PM of the same date i.e. 10th December 2021. Candidates are requested to check the website www.webscte.co.in. for institute wise vacancy.

Admission in the 1^{st} year Diploma Course in Pharmacy will be made on the basis of Merit List as per the vacancy list provided in the website, www.webscte.co.in.

Candidates who are admitted in any Polytechnics previously cannot be allowed to exercise the option of SPOT ADMISSION.

List of Documents to be brought by the Candidates (In original)

- 1. Age Proof
- 2. Aadhar Card and self-attested copy of Aadhar Card
- 3. Mark Sheet for Madhyamik or Equivalent examination and a self-attested copy of same
- 4. Caste Certificate where applicable.
- 5. Previous Application for the Pharmacy Session 2021, if applied online previously

Applicable Fees:

- 1. Application fees- Rs.450/-
- 2. Admission and Tuition fee for 1st year (approximatelyRs.1000/-) to be charged by the Institute on the day of admission.

Modalities for 1st Year admission to Diploma Course in Pharmacy:

A. Modalities of WBSCT&VE&SD (TED) for admission of the candidates to Diploma Courses in Pharmacy (Government) for the Academic Session 2021-2022 as stated:

In keeping with the PCI Guidelines a candidate can seek admission to D. Pharma Course if:

- a. He/she has passed 10+2 in Science Academic Stream with Physics and Chemistry with Mathematics/ Biology.
- b. Further, it may be noted that as per Circular issued by Director of Medical Education vide HPT/1P-04-10/PT-VI/M-532 dated 26th July 2021, students who have passed HS (10+2) or equivalent exams in Vocational stream or distance education will not be eligible for admission to D.Pharma Course in 2021

B. Guidelines and Tie-breaking Policy for preparation of Merit List for admission to Diploma Course in Pharmacy in (Government) for the Academic Session 2021-2022 as stated:-

- a. Rank of the candidate in the merit list has been made based on aggregate marks obtained in Higher Secondary or equivalent examination.
- b. If same marks have been scored by two or more candidates, the one who got higher marks in chemistry get preference in ranking.
- c. If tie exists, candidates who scored higher marks in physics get preference.
- d. If the tie exists, candidates who scored higher marks in Biology/Mathematics get preference
- e. Finally, if the tie remains, the candidates older in age will be preferred.

Step by Step process to be followed by the Institutes Authority for SPOT ADMISSION

- 1. The Institutes will handout blank printed application form for the candidates to fill till $1:00\ PM$.
- 2. Candidates will submit the forms with all relevant documents at the Institutes.
- 3. Institutes will prepare the Merit list and rank wise candidates will be called to fill up online form along with choice of course.
- 4. Candidates who have already applied online (against which a document is presented) will not need to pay application fee again.
- 5. Institute will complete the process and admit the candidate.
- 6. The final admission list against vacancy will be sent to Council for reconciliation under the signature of Principal/ Principal-in-Charge.
